- Each entry must be fully described according to the class being entered as per the schedule.
- Each entry form must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fees.
- Entry forms together with the fees may be submitted to any of the Committee detailed below
- Prize winning entries in Knitwear and Arts & Crafts are not eligible for entry in the same class in any subsequent year
- Exhibits for sale must be clearly marked by the exhibitor with the price and it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to collect such price from the purchaser
- No exhibit may be removed from the Showfield until after 4.30pm on Show Day
- In the event of any dispute the decision of the Chairperson for the Show will be final.

KNITWEAR

RULES AND GUIDANCE - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING YOUR ENTRY FORM

All Over Fair Isle (AOFI) and fair isle (FI) entries should use only two colours per round/row and carry a limited number of stitches along the back of the work. Entries with 3 or more colours per round/row or with large blocks of colour (e.g. intarsia) will be moved to the relevant FANCY STITCH class at the discretion of the convenors/judges.

Fancy stitch or plain entries may include garter stitch, stocking stitch, Aran, cable, brioche, 3 stranded knitting, double knitting, intarsia, textured, mosaic, slip stitch etc. Entries incorporating two or more different types of knitting (e.g. fair isle and cables) should be entered in the relevant fancy stitch class.

Jamieson and Smith (J&S) Colourbox entries must use at least 5 of the 8 prescribed colours. The prescribed colours can be purchased from Jamieson & Smith, 90 North Road, Lerwick.

Ribs and yoke bodies may be machine knitted in all handknit classes (including Children's Section).

Entries of your own design (as opposed to following a published

pattern) should be highlighted with an asterisk (*) on entry forms.

Garments include jumpers, lumbers, slipovers, waistcoats etc.

Accessories (acc) include neckwear (scarf, snood, cowl, scarf, tie etc.), gloves, mitts, socks, ponchos, wraps etc.

Items include blankets, cushion covers, bags, bunting, bookmarks, lampshades, soft furnishings etc.

Entrants wishing to sell their entries should ensure that all items are clearly priced.

Exhibits must be received on the Friday night before the Show Day between 6.30pm and 9pm.

Exhibits must not be removed before 4.30pm on Show Day.
