- NOTE – All Sheep are to be entered in ONE class ONLY
- All sheep and goats must be tagged to comply with current regulations
- Transportation details for all livestock must be completed on the entry form
- Each entry form must show the entrant's full name, address and contact number
- Under 16s must state their age and class on the entry form
- Separate entry forms must be used for each section
- Each entry must be fully described according to the class being entered as per the schedule
- Each entry form must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fees
- Entry forms together with the fees may be submitted to any of the Committee detailed below
- No exhibit may be removed for the Showfield until after 4.30pm on Show Day
- In the event of any dispute the decision of the Chair Person for the Show will be final

1. Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue. Society rosettes must be only given to ponies registered with society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals).
2. Three year old fillies with foals may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.
3. There must be no colts or entire males in the Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in in-hand classes. Children under 11 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by handlers aged 14 years and under in the in-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.
4. To enter a stallion in ANY class (in-hand or performance) at an affiliated show, entire males 4 years old and over must have an "S" number and have been successfully through either SPS-BS Stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPS-BS Voluntary Veterinary Examination. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In hand colts/stallions of two years old or over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a colt or stallion bridle badge, these are available to purchase from the SPS-BS.

**Pony entrants to state on entry form how many pens they need**

**"Rider must have permanent residential address in the show area."**

**Details of transporter must be shown on entry form.**

**Horses and ponies that are being ridden should be 4 years old and over**

**The location on the horse classes will not be changed due to weather.**
